ATTENDED FUNERAL - our professional service charges only **£2,664**

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements, our professional service fee. £1095

Collecting and transporting your loved one from the place of death into our premises. £250

Your loved one will be cared for solely in our premises, from the day we bring them into our care. £185

Provision of our "Classic Oak Coffin", in either a light or dark oak veneer. £599

UNATTENDED FUNERAL - This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, however they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (funeral director's charges only, disbursements not included). £1,295

FEES YOU MUST PAY

The burial fee, in the local area the typical cost of a burial fee for local residents is:

Please note, that there are many extra charges when purchasing a new plot, or for an existing grave with a memorial in place.

In addition the charges vary for a non-resident of the local area. These fees are set by the local council. £875 - £2,995

An attended cremation fee, in the local area the typical cost of a cremation is: £778 - £1,0495

We will collect your loved ones ashes from the Crematorium free of charge, and bring them to our premises. We have a large variety of urns, caskets and also memorial jewellery for you to look at in our office.

Embalming, preparing and dressing your loved one for viewing in our Chapel of Rest. £185

Funeral Officiant, for example a celebrant or minister of religion. From £230

You may choose to take care of some arrangements without our involvement, or you can use an alternative supplier. The burial fee or interment fee is the charge for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening an existing grave. In England, Wales and Northern Ireland you will usually need to pay doctors' fees to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
